360 Elizabeth Stone To	Deed	The State of South Carolina Greenville County This Indenture made the ninth day of October, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy seven, between Elizabeth Stone of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid of the first part and E. Smart Burnham and Norman B. Hammett of the same place of the second part. Whereas the said Elizabeth Stone is desirous to make provision for her daughters Nancy C. Stone & L. N. Stone now minor children against future contingencies and for their maintainances and supports and whereas, the said Elizabeth Stone is desirous that her said daughters should enjoy the proceeds, rents, issues, and income of the estate herein after more particularly described, during the term of their minority free from the control, liabilities, or interference of any person, Now therefore this indenture witnesseth that the said Elizabeth Stone in consideration of the premises, and all my personal effects and of the sum one dollar, to me in hand paid by the parties of second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained sold, aliened, remised, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents doth bargain sell, alien, remise release convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land and all my personal effects, situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid Beginning on a stone corner of John Kenner's thence on said Kenner's line six chains to a stake corner thence on Berry Pool 56 3/4 E. 92 chs to stake x thence to the beginning corner containing one half acre, also one other piece or parcel of land adjoining the above land Beginning at a stone corner of James Hyde dec'd thence S 66 W P O x thence to a stake, thence to the beginning stone corner containing one acre Together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances
