said for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and forty four Dollars and forty four cents to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Charles Green Cannon and John Sandy Cannon in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Charles Green Cannon and John Sandy Cannon all of that tract or parcel of land in the County and State aforesaid conveyed to me by John Pritchey Dill and Caroline Dill, by their joint deed dated September 9th 1875 and recorded in the Register of mensurancyance Book 9 & page 385 on Sept 11th 1875 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Charles Green Cannon and John Sandy Cannon & their heirs and assigns forever, and we do hereby bind ourselves & our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Charles Green Cannon and John Sandy Cannon & their heirs and assigns, against us and our heirs and all others lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
