 d-enture made the nine tenth day  
 of February, one thousand eight

hundred and seventy eight between George Smith of Oak Lawn  
 Township, County and State aforesaid of the first part and G. W.  
 Smith of Gantt Township of County and State aforesaid of the  
 second part, witnesseth, - whereas the said George Smith is  
 desirous to make provision for his son G. W. Smith against future  
 contingencies and for his maintenance and support, and also  
 for that of his children free from the control of any one.  
 Now therefore this indenture witnesseth: that in consideration of  
 the natural love and affection I have unto my son G. W. Smith  
 of the place and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and  
 released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and  
 release (for the consideration of one dollar lawful money  
 of the United States to me in hand paid, the receipt of which  
 is hereby acknowledged) unto the said G. W. Smith, during his  
 natural life, and then to descend to his lawful issue in fee, all  
 that tract or parcel of land lying and being situated in Oak Lawn  
 Township County & State aforesaid, on the head branches of the  
 South Reedy fork, waters of Reedy River, containing one hun-  
 dred and eighteen acres more or less and having the metes  
 and bounds according to plat plat herunto annexed, being the  
 same tract of land I purchased of Adam Jones dec'd on the  
 Twentieth day of November Eighteen hundred and fifty two,  
 Together with all and singular the rights members and appur-  
 tenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident  
 or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the  
 premises before mentioned unto the said G. W. Smith, during his  
 life, and then to his heirs and assigns forever, and I do  
 hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to  
 warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto
