that I Henry J. Houff of Greer-  
ville County in the State

aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by  
J. G. Glenn of Greenville County in the State aforesaid (the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained  
sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
and release unto the said J. G. Glenn all that piece parcel or  
tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville County and State  
aforesaid on the West side of the White Horse road containing  
twenty four acres be the same more or less Beginning at a Rock 3x3x  
in the cross of the White Horse and Pickens roads in the neigh-  
orhood of Berea meeting House thence S 80 1/4 E 19.00 chs on John  
Houff's line to Rock 3x3x n.m. thence S 9 1/4 W 14.82 chs on Philip  
Houff's line to rock 4x3 n.m. Philip Houff's corner thence South 80  
East 14.50 chs said Loggins Gibbons' line to rock 4x3 n.m. on said  
White Horse road thence N 1 E 7.25 chs to bend in White Horse  
Road thence N 9 1/4 E 5.04 chs on White Horse Road to the begin-  
ing rock corner in the fork of White Horse and said Pickens  
road. reference to a Plat herunto annexed will fully appear  
The first twelve acres next to John Houff's line, having been  
surveyed on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of February 1872 by W. D. Smallwood and  
the second twelve acres having been surveyed on the 11<sup>th</sup>  
day of January 1878 by W. W. Hunt Together with all and  
singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or  
appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the  
said premises before mentioned unto the said J. G. Glenn his  
heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my  
heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever  
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said  
J. G. Glenn his heirs and assigns, against me and my  
heirs, every other person lawfully claiming, or to claim the  
same or any part thereof
