in consideration of your integrity and skill full power is hereby  
given to you any two or more of you to take the Renunciation  
of Mrs Cornelia A Thompson widow of Genl Waddy Thompson  
deceased residing in the County of Madison and State of Florida  
of her Dower in the premises herein after described to wit  
for a Deed from Waddy Thompson to W B Thompson, dated  
the day of September in the year Eighteen hundred and  
fifty seven (1857) and recorded in the Office of Register of  
Main conveyance for the State and County aforesaid in Book  
of Page 736 and 737 conveying all that tract of land situate on  
the East side of the Rutherford road in the State and County  
aforesaid, one and a half miles from the Town of Greenville  
joining lands of Dr L B Stone, John Wittenben, Mrs L B Cole  
and others, and containing sixty two acres, more or less, For  
this purpose you will cause the said Mrs Cornelia A Thomp-  
son to appear before you, and you will examine her priv-  
ately and separately, apart from all other persons and  
if upon such examination, she shall freely declare that  
she does freely, voluntarily and without any compulsion  
dread or fear of any person or persons whatsoever, renun-  
ce, release and forever relinquish to George Marshall  
his heirs and assigns, all her interest and Estate, and also all  
her right and claim of Dower of in and to all and singular  
the premises described and conveyed in the deed aforesaid,

Then you shall take under her hand a certificate of her renun-  
ciation as aforesaid in the form of a declaration upon  
private examination as aforesaid, which certificate authenticated  
by your hands and seals, you shall annex to this writ.  
And having certified under your hands and seals, the due  
execution of this writ and verified the same by the oath  
of one of you before some Magistrate whom is authorized  
by the law of your State to administer an oath and whose  
official signature may be properly authenticated, you  
shall carefully return this writ, together with your proceedings  
thereon, to the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas and Gen-  
eral Sessions for the County of State aforesaid to be duly  
recorded herein fail not
