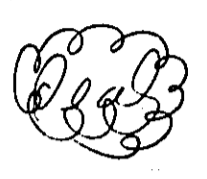

Hudson deceased. Beginning on a stone 3 x 0 three 8 1/2 W 67.15 to a stone 3 x 0 three 8 1/4 W 31.75 to a stone 3 x 0 Maple 3 x n three 8 3 E 68.10 to a Hickory 3 x 0 three 8 3 E 21.75 to a stone 3 x n three 8 4 1/2 W 1.06 to a stone 3 x n three 8 7 1/4 E 11.50 to a Hickory 3 x 0 three 8 7 1/2 E 1.12 to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William A. Hudson and to his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William A. Hudson his heirs & assigns
