The State of South Carolina
To all to whom these presents
shall come; I Perry D. Gilreath
Sheriff of Greenville County

and State aforesaid, send greeting; whereas, by virtue of a writ of
Fieri Facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for
the County of Greenville, dated the nineteenth day of April in the
year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy eight at
the suit of J. Q. McDavid, Plaintiff against W. A. Hudson to me di-
rected, commanding me, that of the goods and chattels, lands and
tenements of W. A. Hudson to levy the sum of Twenty Three ^{68/100}
dollars damages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and
tenements of the said W. A. Hudson all that certain piece, parcel
and tract of land, containing One hundred and sixty four acres
more or less, situate and being in the County of Greenville, in the
State aforesaid, on branch waters of Rocky Creek and Eurer
River adjoining lands of W. H. Austin, J. W. Ross and others.
And whereas, the said premises, with their appurtenances, since the
seizure by me made, by virtue of the said writ of Fieri
Facias before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public
vendue, and purchased by Samuel J. Douthitt of the County of
Greenville in the State of South Carolina for the sum of two
dollars being the highest sum that was bidder therefor, Now
know ye that I Perry D. Gilreath, Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue
of said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid, to me directed and deliv-
ered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the statute in such case
made and provided, and for and in consideration of the said
sum of Two dollars to me in hand paid, or secured to be paid
by the said Samuel J. Douthitt the receipt and payment where-
of I do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold
and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the
said Samuel J. Douthitt his heirs and assigns forever the
said tract piece and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and
all the Estate right title and interest which the said W. A.
Hudson of right had of in and to the same: To have and
to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land, with its
appurtenances, unto the said Samuel J. Douthitt his heirs
and assigns forever as fully and absolutely, as I the
said Perry D. Gilreath might could or ought to grant barg-
ain and sell the same by virtue of the statute aforesaid
