 a certain tract of land situated in Greenville County in the  
 head waters of South Pacolet and north of Saluda River  
 containing one seventy five acres more or less beginning  
 on a rock corner near the road running from the Mount-  
 ain Hill Church to the George Lindsey Place at the head  
 of the hollow thence down the hollow to the branch thence  
 down the branch to rock corner on Charles Gossells line  
 thence with Charles Gossells line to a striking corner thence  
 East course to a Poplar corner thence S. E. course to a
