To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Sarah McPherson her heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Sarah McPherson her heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs and every other person lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
