Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said tract of land belonging or in anywise appertaining, To have and to hold said tract of land unto the said John Cooly his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and defend the said tract of land unto the said John Cooly his heirs and assigns from myself my heirs and assigns and all other persons whatsoever lawfully claiming the same on any part thereof.
