O. x 8 on nearly Ridge Road thence along said Road 4.50 to stone thence due South to beginning corner containing six and one half acres more or less reserving from said tract in trust one and one fourth acres from the original section corner along R. M. Clark line less thence 2 1/2 1/2 together with all
