Also all that Tract of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid adjoining lands of Mrs Townsend, Benjamin Johnson and others and containing one hundred and thirty acres more or less, being the same tracts of land conveyed by me as Probate Judge to the said O P Mills in two separate deeds, bearing date the 2^d December 1818. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Tract of land belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversions and remainders, rents issues and profits thereof. And also all the Estate, right, title, interest, dower, possession property, benefit, claim and demand whatsoever, both at law and in Equity of all the parties to the said suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof, by, from, or under them, or either of them. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the said Junion Eskew his heirs and assigns against myself and heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
