To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Andrew M Remion his heirs and assigns forever, and we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Andrew M Remion his heirs and assigns, against us and our heirs, and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Mary Waldrop subject to the foregoing reservation her heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mary Waldrop her her heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, & every other person lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
