Agreements

The State of South Carolina Whereas Daniel Fowler late of Greenville County in the State aforesaid executed

his last will and testament on the eighth day of July 1878, with a codicil thereto dated the thirteenth day of December 1878, which said last will and testament and codicil have been duly proven both in common and solemn form, and whereas by the provisions thereof certain real and personal property is directed to be divided amongst the children of said Daniel Fowler, at the decease of his wife Mrs. Mary Fowler, and whereas all parties in interest are willing and anxious to anticipate such division and make the same now. Now therefore know all men by these presents that we Mrs. Mary Fowler widow, James F. Fowler, W. S. Fowler, Prudence W. Fowler, and Lawrence A. Fowler being all of age and all single, and being the sole heirs at law and legatees of said Daniel Fowler deceased in consideration of the premises do hereby mutually covenant and agree to and with each other (the said James F. Fowler in his own right and as trustee) to make said division directed by said last will and testament forthwith, reserving to Mrs. Mary Fowler her life's interest in the homestead of two hundred and seventy five ~~acres~~ and also in the household and kitchen furniture and in the articles which she is entitled to and may select under the second clause of said last will and testament, and we do hereby ratify and confirm and agree to abide by said last will and testament and codicil in all

respects, save as hereby modified
