Francis Edwards			Know all men by these presents, that I Dorcas Dill of Greenville

County and in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and seventy five Dollars to me in hand paid by Francis Edwards of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Francis Edwards a tract piece or parcel of land lying & being situate in the County and State aforesaid on the Fox Branch waters of Eures River and is part of a tract of land conveyed to me by J. M. Rennie County Auditor of Greenville County South Carolina the 18th day of September 1874 and runs as follows, Beginning on Red Oak \times on side of Mill Road, thence S 71 E 24.10 chains to pile of stones on Fox Branch, thence up the meanderings of said Branch 16.53 chains to stone \times in branch thence N 55 1/2 W 27.20 chs to a stake \times to Spanish Oak down thence S 13 3/4 W 13.43 chains to a stone \times , thence N 76 1/4 W 7.60 chs to a stone \times on side of Mill Road, thence S 10 1/4 W 7.31 chains along Road to the beginning Red Oak corner \times containing Forty three acres and two rods more or less bounded by lands of Josephine M. Hines, Mrs Norton A. J. Hoawkins, Middleton Brooks and Mrs Nelson, together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Francis Edwards his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Francis Edwards his heirs and assigns against man and my heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
