Kellitt of Greenville County in the State of aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release, unto the said Sarah A. Kellitt all that piece parcel and tract of land (except that portion on the S West side of a cross fence running North of the Branch between John Daquell & this tract which piece is to remain mine and my wife's and life tenement to go to the aforesaid Sarah A. Kellitt and her heirs) said lands lying on waters of Little Reedy Fork Creek waters of Reedy River and being in the County and State of aforesaid, being the northern portion of that plantation deeded by L. C. Dalling to John Daquell withers beginning at a stone 3x on Ridge way & line thence S 61 1/4 E 31.50 to a stone 3x thence S 45 W 20.90 to a Hickory S 22 W 10.67 to a stone at creek, thence down the meander of said creek to the Bogansch thence up the meander of said Branch to a P. O. 2x thence S 51 W 5.00 to a stone 3x thence N 85 W 9.90 to a stone 5x thence N 55 E 7.40 to stone 3x thence N 35 W 14.15 to a P. O. thence N 61 1/4 W 3.80 to a stone 3x thence N 32 E 11.85 to the beginning stone corner containing one hundred & seventeen acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Sarah A. Kellitt her heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Sarah A. Kellitt her heirs and assigns against all and every other person or persons who may lawfully claim any

claim the same, or any part thereof.
