Marchbanks our undivided eight ninth interest in all that tract or parcel of land situate in Greenville County and State aforesaid about four miles from Greenville Court House beginning at a stake & n.w. corner N 31 E 28.25 chs to a stake or Dogwood & n.w. corner N 52 W 8 chs to stake & n.w. corner S 31 W 26.15 chs to a stake & n. corner S 37 E 8.50 chs to the beginning corner containing twenty two and three fourth acres or more or less and bounded by lot No 1 Watson lot No 5 and 2 and Mrs. Colarks land, and known as lot No 3 in the survey made by H. P. Johnson March 29th 1849 Together with all and singular the right members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; We have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Mary J.
