State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of five hundred  
Dollars to me paid by J. B. Whitmore of Greenville County  
in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and  
released and by these presents do grant bargained sold and  
release unto the said J. B. Whitmore all that certain tract  
of land situate lying and being in Greenville County and  
State aforesaid on the East side of the White Horse Road  
adjoining lands of Ellen Seuggs, G. W. McCarroll and  
others and containing thirty eight and a half acres  
be the same more or less and bounded as follows, begin-  
ning at a white Oak on the White Horse road and  
running thence N 74 1/4 E 45.55 chs to a Rock o x 0.2 m  
thence N 7 1/2 E 56 chs to a Post Oak o x 2 m. thence N 77 W  
31.90 chs to a Cherry tree 3 x 2 m on the East side of the  
White Horse Road thence with the White Horse Road  
as a line to the beginning white Oak corner. Together  
with all and singular the rights members incidents  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or  
in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to  
hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned  
unto the said J. B. Whitmore his heirs and assigns forever  
and I do hereby bind my heirs executors and admin-  
istrators to warrant and forever defend all and  
singular the said premises unto the said J. B. Whitmore  
his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and  
against every other person whatsoever lawfully  
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and eighty and in the one hundred and fifth year of  
the sovereignty and Independence of the United  
States of America.
