three hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid
by Mrs. Catherine Hagan of the said City
of Greenville in the State of South Carolina

conveyed, sold, and released, and by these presents do give, grant,
convey, sell, and release unto the said Mrs. Catherine Hagan
all that piece parcel and lot of land situated lying and
being in that City of Greenville in the County of Greenville
and being bounded the following notes and courses to wit, Beginning
at a point where the old Roger Leland place (now the
mill & stable) intersects Main Street thence along the said
Leland or Leland & Hable line to the recorded & surveyed
four (2-24) feet to Brown Street thence up said Brown
Street in the direction of Washington Street six feet to a
stable thence in the direction of Main Street and on a
line almost parallel with the Leland or Leland and
Hable line two hundred and twenty four feet to
Main Street (striding said Main Street six feet
and five inches (6 ft. 5 in.) from the beginning cor-
ner thence down said Main Street to the Baptist
cross six feet and five inches to being
the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary
together with all and singular the Rights, Liberties,
Privileges and Appurtenances to the said
premises belonging, or in anywise incident or apper-
taining to have and to have all and singular the
said premises before mentioned unto the said
Mrs. Catherine Hagan her heirs and assigns for
ever and do hereby bind myself and my heirs
Executors and Administrators to present and
forever defend and amply secure the said premi-
ses unto the said Mrs. Catherine Hagan her
heirs and assigns against me and my heirs
and other persons whatsoever lawfully claim-
ing or to claim the same, or any part thereof
