of Georgia for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to me paid by Jesse Watson & Robert Pitman Deacons of the Cross Plains Baptist Church in Sumner County in the State of Georgia have granted bargain sold released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jesse Watson & Robert Pitman Deacons of Cross Plains Baptist Church & their successors in office a tract piece or parcel of Land lying and being situated in Sumner County & State of Georgia and both sides of the Ridge Road containing Seven acres be it the same more or less and more as follows: viz Beginning at a White Oak 3+ running thence N 33° 30' W 600' Chais to a Stone Thence S 27° 33' 34" Chais to a Stone 3+ Thence S 63° 26' 00" Chais to a Pine 3+ Thence N 27° 33' 34" Chais to the Beginning White Oak 3+ and bounded by Lands of the Estate of Mrs Sarah Dies Cross Plains Church and myself. Together with all & singular the Rights Members Hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to the same and to give all and confirm the premises hereinafter mentioned unto the said Jesse Watson

and Robert Pitman Deacons of Cross Plains Church and their successors in office for the use of Cross Plains Church and assigns forever and do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to execute and govern signs all and assigns the said premises unto the said Jesse Watson & Robert Pitman Deacons of Cross Plains Church and their successors in office and assigns against me & my heirs and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand & seal this 24th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty and in the one hundred and fifth year of the sovereignty & Independence of the United States of America
