

On Main Street in the City of Greenville and  
 following the following line: West and bounded to west, on  
 the North by 7 Broad Street. On the West by Lot of  
 J. Swandale on the North by Main Cross Street on  
 the N. E. by the Public Square on the East by  
 Main Street from the Public Square to the
