Markley all that lot or parcel of land situated lying and being in the City and County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, Beginning at a stake on Broad Street, thence S 75 30 W 116 feet to a stake on Jackson Street, thence S 72, 30 E 95 feet to a stake, thence N 17 30 W 116 feet to a stake on said Broad Street, thence with said Street N 72 30 W 95 feet to the beginning corner and containing Two hundred and fifty three one thousand of an acre more or less & also all that lot or parcel of land situated lying and being in
