14.77 to a stone or thence N 1/2° W 59.90 to the beginning corner this tract containing seventy seven acres bounded by Ed of Cothran, John A. Williams David C. Williams, Isham Williams and others. The second tract contains seventeen and a half acres beginning at a stone or near a cabin on the road thence S 8 1/2° W 21.00 to a dead pine thence S 35 3/4° E 12.50 to a stone or thence S 76 1/2° E 11.60 to a stone or on the aforesaid Road the road the line to its beginning bounded by M.
