Country and others demanding judgment in relation to the Real Estate therein after exhibited and described and the coming at issue came on to be heard on the 27th day of November 1882 and such proceedings were had thereon as resulted in a decretal order of the said Court whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said Real Estate therein mentioned and described be sold by D. these presents do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Wheeler all that tracts of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid Beginning at a point with Oak & then N 20 W 80 to a Stone & then S 88 1/4 W 2 3/4 to a Stone or Stone & then S 67 1/4 W 15 30 to a Stone & then S 29 1/2 W 2 90 to a White Oak & then S 28 1/4 E 9 00 to a Stone & on a road then along said road 7 50 to a White Oak & then S 34 1/2 E 15 50 to a Stone & then S 85 1/2 E 5 70 to the beginning corner adjoining lands of J. W. Poling and others and containing fourteen and one half acres more or less Together with all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining and all the estate right title claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the case aforesaid and of each of them in and to the same and of all other persons rightfully claiming from and/or by them or any of them
