 lotte Ry, thence N 47° W 50 feet to South West cor-
 ner of Lot No 4, thence N 85 1/2° E 120 feet to the point

 the Rights, members, hereditaments and ap-
 purtenances to the said premises belonging
 or in anywise incident or appertaining,
 To have and to hold, all and singular the
 said premises before mentioned unto the said
 Thomas C. Markley his heirs and assigns for
 ever, And I do hereby bind myself and my
 heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant
 and forever defend all and singular the said
 Thomas L. Markley his heirs and assigns, against

 sons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same
 or any part thereof under me.
