 among his heirs, Bounded from Space Foster to the said
 John Foster situate lying and being in Greenville County
 and state aforesaid, on or near Branches of Gilders
 creek Branch, waters of Enore River Bounded by Land
 of A. V. King, P. J. Vinden and others
