have granted, bargained, sold, aliened and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto the said John B. Goodwin all that certain
piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and
being in Saluda Township, County and State
aforesaid, bounded by lands of B. P. Hammett
and others beginning at a stake on North Saluda
River at the bridge, thence S. 83 3/4 W. 92.3 to a Hickory,
thence S. 77 W. 16.50 across the road to a poplar, thence
S. 83 3/4 W. 29.38 to a stone, thence S. 12 W. 74.73 to Spanish
Oak, thence S. 89 E. 30.20 to the road, thence up the road
as a line to a stone, thence N. 71 E. 13.40 to a stake,
thence N. 68 E. 12.00 to a stake on North Saluda River
thence up the River to the beginning corner. Contain-
