 I, John W. Goodwin of Greenville County in the State  
 of South Carolina for and in consideration of Five Dollars to me

paid by W. C. Goodwin as Trustee of the Linn Baptist Church in the  
 County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, have granted, con-  
 veyed, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, con-  
 vey, sell and release unto the said W. C. Goodwin Trustee  
 of the said Church all that tract, piece, parcel and tract of land  
 containing Two Acres, less three small pieces reserved for  
 Family Cemeteries as hereinafter described and reserved,  
 and runs as follows: Beginning at a stone & x, running  
 thence South 45° 50' chains to an Iron & x, thence East 55° 50' chains  
 to a stone & x, thence North 20° 00' chains to a stone & x, thence  
 North 70° 15' 90' chains to the beginning stone corner, bound-  
 ed on all sides by my own lands. Together with all  
 and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and  
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging in any  
 wise incident or appertaining, except the above reserved  
 three pieces which are described as follows: the first  
 reserved to myself for my Family Cemetery and runs  
 as follows: beginning at a stake & x, thence South 45 feet  
 to a stake & x, thence East 30 feet to a stake & x, thence North  
 45 feet to a stake & x, thence West 30 feet to a stake & x, the begin-  
 ning, containing 1350 square feet. The other two pieces re-  
 served are conveyed to W. C. Goodwin and F. W. Fuller  
 for their family Cemeteries and for a description of the  
 said reference will be had to their respective Deeds  
 of Conveyance dated the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of July 1885. To have  
 and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid  
 unto the said W. C. Goodwin his heirs and assigns  
 forever in trust for the aforesaid Linn Baptist Church  
 to be held, possessed and enjoyed by the said Linn  
 Baptist Church forever as a place of Religious worship  
 and burial place. And I do hereby bind myself my  
 self my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant  
 and forever defend all and singular the said  
 premises unto the said W. C. Goodwin in trust as  
 aforesaid his heirs and assigns against myself  
 and my heirs and every other person whomsoever  
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
