The following Contract & agreement was this day made between Mary M. Butler the first party & James J. Butler the second party. It is agreed to by the said contracting parties that after the death of said first party, that said second party shall take the daughter, Susan, and provide for her comforts & furnish her with Board & suitable clothes & for all expenses of board & clothes during her natural life & the said Susan is to have the

use of her Mother's Bed & Bedding during her natural life & the said second party shall receive a reasonable compensation to be paid to him annually by the Executor of the will of my late Husband, Willis Butler, and if said second party & the Executor of said will cannot agree on the amount to be paid to said second party annually, then it is further more agreed that the amount to be paid to said second party shall be determined by two disinterested men, chosen if they can't agree they shall call in a third & so determine the amount to be paid to said second party annually for the board & trouble of taking care of said Susan, the daughter of said first party. All of which is mutually agreed to by said contracting parties, and they do hereby bind themselves their heirs, executors and administrators well & singularly to the performance of the foregoing Contract & agreement, and said Contract to continue to be in force & binding during the natural life of said first party, Mary M. Butler, and during the natural life of her daughter Susan. This Contract & agreement to commence at the death of Mary M.
