Gower and Whitner Symmes trustees a lot of land hereinafter mentioned and described for the sum of three hundred dollars, went into possession of the same but paid no part of the purchase money and whereas by an order of the Court of Common Pleas for Greenville County in the State aforesaid, made on the 20th day of December 1887 in the case of Whitner Symmes against Whitner Symmes and Thomas C. Gower as trustees and others, it was adjudged that the

order, adjudged and decreed that upon the payment of the purchase money for said lot of land with the interest thereon, that the Master execute and deliver to the said Thomas C. Mansley a deed of conveyance for the lot of land before mentioned and hereinafter described. Now therefore know all men by these Presents, that S. J. Douthick Master in and for the County aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and forty seven dollars to me paid by the said Thomas C. Mansley, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas C. Together with all and singular the rights, liberties, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining and all the estate, right, title, claim, and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid and of each of them, in and to the same, and of all other persons rightfully claiming from under or by them or any of them, to have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas C. Mansley his heirs and assigns forever.
