

That I, Walter S. Gray & D. J. Ellison in the State of South Carolina, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars, to me paid by Cedar Shoals Baptist Church for one acre and one acre given by W. S. Gray and D. J. Ellison for a use as will show on page second, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Waddy J. Jordan and E. M. Holliday Deacons of Cedar Shoals Baptist Church and their successors in office, a lot of land containing two acres, be the same more or less, it being the land on which said Church building now stands, described as follows, beginning on a stone 3 x on Cooleys Bridge Road, thence S. 86° E. 4.50 chains to a stone 3 x 2 m. thence S. 3/4 N. 44° 0 chains to a stone 3 x 2 m. thence N. 86° W. 4.50 chains to a stone 3 x 2 m. on Road, thence N. 3/4 E. 4.50 chains to the beginning. We, W. S. Gray & D. J. Ellison sell one acre and give one acre the land described in this deed for the sole purpose for a burial ground and a place for Church, and if other uses be made of same other than a religious nature we claim the right to the land herein deeded. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, to Have and to Hold, all and singular the premises, before mentioned unto the said Waddy J. Jordan and E. M. Holliday Deacons and their successors in office forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Waddy J. Jordan and E. M. Holliday Deacons and their successors in office against me and my Heirs, and all others lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
