 Do I Deed Know all Men by these Presents
 Lewis E. Burns That I, Joseph S. Ward of Greenville
 County in the State aforesaid, in consideration
 of the sum of Twenty Dollars, to me in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents, by Lewis
 E. Burns, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged, have granted, bargained, sold and released
 and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell
 and release unto the said Lewis E. Burns all
 that piece, parcel and tract of land containing
 three and one half acres, more or less, situate,
 lying and being in the County and State
 aforesaid, about six miles South of Greenville
 Court House near the White Horse Road and
 having the following metes, Courses and distances
 to-wit: Beginning at a stone 3x on Bud Ward's line
 and running thence with John McWhites line N 88 1/2 E.
 7.15 to a stone 3x on Pleasant Walker's line. Thence
 with said line N. 2 E. 4.50 to a stone 3x. Thence S. 88 1/2 W.
 7.14 to a stone 3x on Bud Ward's line. Thence S. 2 1/4 W.
 4.50 to the beginning corner, and adjoining lands
 of Bud Ward, Pleasant Walker and others. The
 same being what is known as Lot No. 3 of the
 Estate of William Ward, deceased, and conveyed
 to - by the Heirs of said Estate, by Deed bearing date
 the - day of November A.D. 1887. Together with all
 and singular the Rights, Members, Benefits, Tenements
 and Appurtenances to the said Premises belong-
 ing, or in anywise incident or appertaining,
 to Have and to Hold all and singular the said
 premises before mentioned unto the said Lewis
 E. Burns his heirs and assigns forever. And
 I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and

 hand paid at and before the sealing of these
 presents, by Mrs. Sallie J. Earle and of the surren-
 der of certain notes which she holds against me,
 she being also of Greenville County in the State
 aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged,) have granted, bargained, sold and re-
 leased and by these presents do grant, bargain
 sell and release unto the said Mrs. Sallie J. Earle
 all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land
 situate, lying and being in the County and
 State aforesaid, on the North side of the Lammus
 road about two miles from the City of Greenville
 Beginning at a Rock 3x, and running thence N 62
 E. 16.40 to a stone 3x. Thence S. 33 1/4 E. 4.08 to a stone 3x
 thence N. 62 E. 19.50 to a stone 3x, thence S. 25 E. 6.02 to a
 stone. Thence 66 1/4 W. 29.75 to a stone on the Lammus
 Road, thence along said Lammus Road, N. 57 1/2 W. 9.00
 to the beginning corner. Containing twenty one acres
 more or less. Less a twenty foot strip on the West
 side, running from the Lammus road to the place
 now or formerly owned by C. F. Hopkins. Also all
