Davenport, all those lots of land in the Town of Greer, containing eight acres, more or less, and also situate, lying and being in the County and State of onesaid, and bounded by lands of Thomas Snow, Samuel J. Paves, (just across a street) the Right of way of the Air Line R.R. and the Public square, and a new Street, not named, on the East side, and includes both the land bought by me from the Glenn Estate and in a plat made by S. Anderson, surveyor, and a part of the land bought by me from W. P. Shurmate. And all included in a plat made by J. B. Williamson surveyor both of which plats defined to said D. D. Davenport with this deed, together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises, or in anywise incident or appertaining, to Have and to Hold, all and singular the said Premises, before mentioned unto the said D. D. Davenport, his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said D. D. Davenport, his heirs and assigns against me, and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
