 gained, sold and released, and by these presents do
 grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mary
 E. Langley, all that piece, parcel or tract of land
 situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville
 and State of South Carolina, on waters of Long Branch, waters
 of Enoree River, containing Two Hundred acres,
 more or less, and adjoining lands of Perry Nobles,
 Jackson Styles, Wm. Linn and John Childers, and
 being my home place and on which I now reside.
