consideration of the sum of eighteen hundred and twenty Dollars to me paid
by the said Matthew P. Nash

whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, DO
GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Matthew P. Nash all that piece

parcel or tract of land situate in said County and State on South Rabon
Creek adjoining lands of Young Nash, John Abernombie and others contain-
ing one hundred thirty two and two thirds acres more or less also all
that tract of land situate in the same County and State on South Rabon
Creek adjoining lands of Thaddeus Cobb and others containing forty
acres more or less

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances to the said
premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim, and interest
whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them, in and to the same; and of all other persons
rightfully claiming from, under, or by these or any of them.
