J. W. C. Brazley of Greenville County in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars, to me

in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Samuel R. Glenn

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Samuel R. Glenn, All that certain parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville State aforesaid in a small parcel of land... beginning at a stone on the corner of the road... containing four acres and one fourth...

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel R. Glenn Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind my heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Samuel R. Glenn Heirs, and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

WITNESS my Hand and Seal this 21st day of August A. D. 1895, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five and in the one hundred and year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
