This indenture made this eighth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven between Mary R Kendrick executrix and J W Walker executor of the last will and Testament of William S Kendrick late of Sandy Bluffs in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina deceased, of the first part and Mrs Anna H Walker J W Kendrick Mrs Manie E James and Mrs Nannie Roe of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part by virtue of the authority to them given in and by the said last will and Testament and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars to Mary R Kendrick executrix and J W Walker executor paid by the said parties of the second part, have granted bargain sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said parties of the second part them and their heirs and assigns forever, all the estate, right title interest property possession claim and demand whatsoever, both in law and equity which the said Testator had at the time of his decease, and which the said parties of the first part have by virtue of the said last will and Testament of William S Kendrick, deceased, of in and to all that one half interest in all that tract or parcel of land situated and lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on both sides of Snowe River beginning on a pine 34 on the north side of said river near the head of the mill pond, thence S 65 30 to the river, S 24 chains to a stake 34, thence N 88 34 E to a stake 34, thence S 76 E 8 to a stake 34, thence to a pine, thence S 84 E 6 30 to a red oak, thence N 56 34 E 14 to a maple 34 on the bank of said river down the meanders of said river to a stake thence N 65 E to a red oak bush 34 thence N 14 W 26 30 to a Spanish oak, thence N 50 W 33 50 to the beginning containing one hundred acres more or less.
