WHEREAS A.G. Furman proposes to organize a corporation to be known as SALUDA RIVER POWER COMPANY for the purpose of developing the power of Saluda River by erecting and maintaining a dam or dams across Saluda river at or near a certain point (to be hereafter located by said A.G. Furman or his assigns), on the lands of R.A. Means in Greenville and Pickens Counties, to the height of thirty nine feet above low water and whereas I am the owner of certain lands lying on or near said river which will be affected more or less by the pond of back water created by said Dam or Dams.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I Samuel M. Cox of the County of Pickens in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred and fifteen 00/100 dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by A.G. Furman

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said A.G. Furman a portion of my said lands situate in the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, containing by estimation twenty-five 05/100 acres, more or less, being that portion of land which will be covered by said pond of back water, and having such shape and lines as are represented on a Plat or Map made by Green and Co. dated August 1904, said portions as aforesaid being a portion of land and tract of land owned by me

together with the right to erect and maintain said dam or dams and to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said A.G. Furman, his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said A.G. Furman, his heirs and assigns against me and my Heirs, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof;
