(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thos. R. Russell, all that piece, part or lot of land, situate, lying and being, containing more or less in the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and State aforesaid, known as Lot No. 3 on a plat made by J. J. Southern, Esq., representing a subdivision of the Biggs Block and that is recorded in the office of the Clerk of the County of Greenville in Book 9, at Page 99. Said lot being conveyed to me pursuant to deed, to wit: Deed of my late father of lot conveyed by me to said Thos. R. Russell (shown as lot No. 4 as shown on said plat) on March 10, 1904, and running thence S 81° 16' 00" E 60 feet (more or less) to the old boundary line corner of said Lot No. 4 shown on said plat, 60 feet along said boundary to the corner of said Lot No. 3 of said subdivision, thence N 75° 30' 00" E 60 feet to the corner of said subdivision of Lot No. 3, thence S 81° 16' 00" E 60 feet along said boundary to the corner, containing 9730 feet square, more or less. This lot is a part of a certain lot conveyed to me by Dr. Samuel Masters by deed bearing date January 1st, 1904, and recorded in said R. 7720 Office in deed book K. K. 11 at page 801.

And D. do hereby bind, myself and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Thos. R. Russell His Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
