And I do hereby bind my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Heirs and Assigns forever.

Heirs and Assigns, against my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
