Cooley of the State and County aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John T. Cooley all our undivided interest in all that piece parcel and tract of land, situate lying and being in the County of Greenville, and State aforesaid and Township containing Half and one fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) acre more or less, and bounded by lands of Cindy Hollings, Willie Seabourne and Georgia Davenport, and lying on the Cooley's Bridge and Palmetto Road and being the same tract of land conveyed by D. W. Turner, Master to Minnie Jordan for life and at her death to ourselves and others in fee simple by deed bearing date the 4 day of January, 1897, and recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds County of said County in Book 6 C. O. page 14, of a particular description of which reference is hereby made to said deed of conveyance.
