Stone, and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises in a proper manner with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right at all times, to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other like obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same. no Guy wire to be used on place, it is agreed that Sou. Power Co., will not cut any more timber than is absolutely necessary, Power Co. to pay for timber cut and all damage to crops or other property.
