KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Thomas Fleming Parker, Jr. of the County and State aforesaid, do hereby make, constitute and appoint my Father Thomas F. Parker of the County of Greenville, State aforesaid my true, sufficient and lawful Attorney, for me and in my name to transact all of my business, with full power to sell and transfer any property, real or personal of whatsoever kind that I may possess, and to execute such deeds, conveyances or instruments of assignment as may be necessary for said purpose, and with full power to invest any and all funds coming into his hands for me in such was as he may deem advisable, and to re-vest and sell the substituted property as often as may be necessary.

And with full power to receive, dividends, interest and any other profits upon my stock and property belonging to me, and with power to sign checks, to execute proxies, and to vote my stock in any and all meetings of stockholders; with full power to do any and all acts that may be necessary in order to attend to any of my business; and my Attorney shall not be held responsible for any mistake or judgement in the exercise of any of the powers conferred upon him which may be injurious to my estate.

I do give and grant unto my said Attorney power to do all acts and things necessary and requisite to the carrying out of the purposes of this instrument as fully as I could do if personally present.

Ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney shall do by virtue of the powers herein conferred.
