Now, Therefore, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Thomas Vick, in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of One Dollar to me in hand paid at and before the deliver of these presents by the said Laura Vick, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, release and convey unto the said Laura Vick all my right and interest in the said Children and all my right of having the custody and control of the said children during their minority.

And I do further agree not to interfere in any way with the said Laura Vick in the custody and control and care of said children and not to molest in any way the said Laura Vick or the said children.

To have and to hold the said children and the right to the custody and control thereof unto the said Laura Vick, her heirs and assigns forever.
