County of Greenville.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mrs. Olalie Finlay, of the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and ninety-eight dollars and sixty-eight cents (\$498.68), to me in hand paid by Southern Power Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the Southern Power Company, its successors and assigns a right of way one hundred (100) feet in width, that is fifty (50) feet on either side of the line now located across my tract of land hereinafter described said line beginning at a point on the Southerly line of said tract of land, distant twelve hundred and five (1205) feet in a Westwardly direction from a light-wood stake 3X0M a corner of said property, and said line running; thence across said property N. 73 W. 1166 feet, more or less. And the right to construct and maintain in, upon and through said strip in a proper manner with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity; together with the right at all times to enter upon said strip of land for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away all trees and other like obstructions within said one hundred (100) foot strip that may in any way endanger the proper operation of said lines. The tract of land across which said right of way extends is my tract on Brushy Creek, in the County and State aforesaid, containing three hundred and eighty-one (381) acres, more or less, conveyed to me by deed dated June 10th, 1898 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for said County in Book "000" page 397.
