WHEREAS, on the 14th., day of February, A.D. 1905, W.B. Campbell of said County and state did grant to the National Light and Thorium Company, a corporation of Delaware, certain rights on his land in Grove Town-ship, said County and State adjoining lands of John-Tollatt, J.L. Rhodes and P.D. Huff, which rights are set forth in an agreement dated February 14th., 1905 and recorded in the office of the Register of Meson Conveyance, of said County in Book M.M.M. at page 322, and WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of January, A.D. 1905 said Campbell did sell said land to J.L. Rhodes as is recorded in the office of the Register aforesaid in book R.R.R. at page 306 and, WHEREAS, it is the desire of said Rhodes and said ^{Company} ~~Campbell~~ to alter said agreement, now therefore, this agreement made this 8th., day of february A.D. 1906 between J.L. Rhodes of R.F.D. # 6, Greenville, Post-office Greenville County, South Carolina, and National Light and Thorium Company a corporation of Delaware; Witnesseth, that said agreement of February 14th., 1905 is hereby amended as follows; The said Company hereby agrees not to mine for monizite in the bottom lands and hillsides on said land, but only in the beds and runs of the Creek and branches on said land and such small strips of land immediately adjoining same as may be advantageously cut off in order to straighten the courses of said creek or branches, the said Company further agrees that in working Tollett's Creek the ditch shall be ~~run~~ ^{run} on the right hand bank going down ^{to} said creek and so far as possible the gravel shall be thrown on the left hand side of said Creek.

the said Rhodes in consideration of the agreements of the said Company specified in the foregoing paragraph hereby releases said Company from the obligation of said agreement of February 14th., 1905 to pay royalties to the ~~said~~ ^{said} owner and to work the property within a specified time and not to suspend operation for more than six months without forfeiting of the rights of said Company and said Rhodes hereby confirms to the said Company all other rights in said agreement of February 14th., 1905 except those which said company specifically relinquishes as set forth in the foregoing paragraph hereof. The said Company shall no right to use any of the timber or wood on said land except such sapplings and brush as are needed in the construction of Dams. In witness whereof the said Rhodes has hereunto set his hand and seal at his residence in said County and State on the 8th., day of February 1906 and said Company has caused these presents to be signed by its President and attested by its Secretary and its Corporate seal affixed hereto at Youngstown, Ohio, the 14th., day of February 1906. executed in the presence of.
