

The State of South Carolina,

This memorandum of agreement made and entered into this 23rd, day of October, A.D. 1901, by and between Jacob W. Cagle, of the City and County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, Party of the first part, and the Board of Trustees of the Greenville-Female College, Parties of the second part: Witnesseth; That the party of the first part has agreed to donate and does hereby donate to the parties of the Second part, One Thousand dollars towards the erection and completion of the East wing of the "Greenville Female College" building, upon the conditions hereinafter set forth:-

First: That the parties of the second part set apart in said East wing a room to be known as "Lula Cagle Hall of Vocal Music", being the North-east room, on the first floor of said East wing the entrance to which is in front of, and opposite the North end of the Main entrance of said East Wing of Said College building.

Second: That said Parties of the Second part causes to be inscribed over the door of said room, opposite the North end of said main entrance, and in full view from said entrance in gilt letters "Lula Cagle Hall of Vocal Music".

Third: That said Parties of the Second part, shall and every year a gold medal, to be known as the "Lula Cagle Medal", which shall be publicly presented, as a part of the commencement exercises of said College each year, to the pupil in the Vocal Music Department of said College, who shall merit the same by reason of superior excellence in vocal music.

Fourth: That said Parties of the Second part causes to be inserted under the proper heading, in the Catalogue of said Greenville Female College, each year, that said medal will be presented as above mentioned.

Fifth: In case of failure on the part of the parties of the second part, or their successors in office, to comply with the conditions above set forth, or with any one of said conditions then and in that case, it is understood, and hereby declared, that upon such failure the donation above mentioned shall be forfeited and the amount of said donation shall revert to the party of the first part, or if he be dead to his Estate.

And the said parties of the second part hereby accept the said donation of One Thousand dollars, hereinabove mentioned, upon the terms and conditions annexed to the same, and hereby agree for themselves and their successors in office to comply with the same.

In witness whereof the party of the first part has hereunto set his hand and seal and the Parties of the Second part have hereunto set their hands and caused the seal of the said Female College to be affixed, the day and year first above written
