On condition that he shall pay all taxes thereon and also the sum of Seven hundred and fifty Dollars, in the following manner;

Ten dollars per month on the first day of each calendar month after date until the full purchase price is paid, with interest on same from date at eight per cent per annum until paid; to be computed and paid annually, and if unpaid to bear interest until at the same rate as principal, and in case said sum or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or through legal proceedings of any kind, then in addition the sum of ten per cent for attorney's fee, and said J.E.
