This Indenture made and entered into on 5th. day of Aug. 1909, Witnesseth:

That we, Samuel and Nancy Raines the parents of a four weeks old female child named Annie Unice Raines, in consideration of the conditions and stipulations hereinafter set forth, and in consideration of the fact that C.B. Bates, hereinafter named, residing at Travelers-Rest S.C. R.F.D. No. 3 in said County and State, has bound himself in writing to perform the stipulations and conditions hereinafter set forth,

We, do hereby apprentice, release, surrender and transfer unto the said C.B. Bates the custody, company and service of said Annie Unice Raines, who is too young to make a contract or to sign her own name.

II, in consideration of the foregoing said C.B. Bates is to support, cloth, educate and train said Annie Unice Raines in a manner becoming a person in his station in life.

III This contract and agreement is to be mutually binding upon us and the said C.B. Bates until the said Annie Unice Raines shall arrive at the full lawful age of twenty-one years.

It is the purpose and intention of this agreement to substitute the said C.B. Bates, in our stead as parents of said child, so far as the custody, company and service of said child is concerned on the one hand and so far as the duty and obligation to support, educate and train on the other hand as the law will permit and to this end it is mutually agreed that this contract is irrevocable and shall be recorded in the office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for said County and State, so as to give notice to the world the contents thereof.
