(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ollie Williams all my right, title, claim, and interest arising by right of dower, as the widow of Joab Langford deceased for surviving in any other right, with all that, physical parcel or plantation of land situated in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina on the East side of South Saluda River, adjoining lands of said Ollie Williams, Edwin Fowler and others containing seventy-three acres, more or less, and being known as the Michael Whitwire Place, and the same land conveyed to Joab Langford by S. B. Dickson by deed recorded in deed book G. O. 14 page 803 in the Register's office for said County.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Ollie Williams His Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Ollie Williams His

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
